Psalms 121 (Please pray antiphonally.)

I lift up my eyes to the mountains—
where does my help come from?
My help comes from the Lord,

Indeed, he who watches over Israel
will neither slumber nor sleep.

The Lord watches over you—

Response to the Reading - Promise of Commitment

Cards are distributed.

Leader: In stillness, let us come before the God Who loves us.

(A Time of Communal Contemplation)

Leader: Let us commit ourselves to full participation in Chapter 2023.

(Sisters sign their commitment)

Sisters voice their commitment together, in these words:

**I, Sister _____, because I am loved by God and called to full participation
in our IHM Congregation, I commit myself to Chapter 2023.**

*Community affirms the commitments - (The Leader will name five or six sisters and the
community will continue the affirmation until all sisters are affirmed.)*

Leader: Sisters __, __, __, __, __,

All: you are loved by God and are beloved members of our community.
We affirm your commitments.

After the last set of sisters are affirmed, the commitment cards are collected.

The leader places the cards on the altar, saying:

May these cards serve as a reminder of our promise.

making room for the Providence of God in the face of an unknown future.

Empower us to be
faithful witnesses *to chastity*.

Empower us to be open to the transforming movement of Your Spirit within us.
